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Abstract	This is an intermediate level English Listening and Speaking
	course designed, based on college-level topics and skills, to enhance
	students' listening and speaking ability. Students will be trained to
	develop the listening and speaking skills (e.g. note-taking, using
	context clues, asking for and giving clarification) they need to feel
	confident in familiar situations. They should be able to handle the
	basic communication in everyday situations. A range of topics/
	tasks in the main textbook along with supplementary authentic
	materials will be used. Students' presentations and contributions to
	discussion and group activities during teaching sessions will be
	important, as they are part of assessment requirements.
Goal	To successfully complete this course, students should demonstrate
	the ability to understand and convey in simple English in everyday
	situations.
Method	Lectures, video and film clips watching, and class activities.
Requirement	Students are required
	1. to do in-class/take-home assignments.
	2. to take midterm exam and final examination.
	3. to provide written explanation or official documentation for
	excused absence.
	4. to log on to E-Learning on a regular basis for class materials and
	announcements.
